Praise God for His working on our behalf. We now have 2 young couples showing interest in attending though they have not committed to coming. Some of these young people are definitely showing signs of God working in their hearts, but have not yet made a public profession of faith. They have so many beliefs based in religion, pop-psychology, superstition and culture that have to be overcome before repentance towards God and faith in Christ becomes real in their hearts. We are so excited right now as a few are so close to trusting Christ. We continue to work with these young people almost daily and pray for them. **We ask that you will specifically pray for Gustavo, Adrian, Jonny, Fiama, Yoni, Alejo, Yesica, Graciela, Claudio, Santiago, Gaby and Gaston.** All are between 12 and 23 years old and each one needs to be saved!

We have a youth outing planned in May, which we will take as many as can go to participate with 2 other youth groups in Rosario about 90 minutes away from here. Also, during the next few weeks, Greg will be teaching two separate blocks of instruction at the seminary in Rosario.

We have been praying to God for provision for a property for the church. The one we had in mind has become available. It is located on the busiest street in our neighborhood and there is a bus stop right across the street. Some would say, how can we expect to buy a property during the current economic crisis. But I say, that I am expecting God to provide it and He is not having a financial crisis! We have two years left on our current lease and if God would provide this we could build as we go, therefore not incurring any debt. Also the people here would have the satisfaction of contributing to their building. We only ask of you to pray with us concerning this, and that God will truly provide as only He can!

We as a family, truly appreciate your faithful prayers for us and this ministry and your continued financial support! We pray that God will continue to bless each of you, abundantly.
