This month we have summer camps to go to. Greg will be taking 3 different groups to 3 different camps. This will be the first summer bible camp for some of our youth. Pray that they will grow spiritually and that God will work in their lives. We also have a church social planned this month.

Next month, the seminary in Rosario starts back up. Our daughter, Hannah will start her first year there. Greg will begin teaching toward the end of February.
